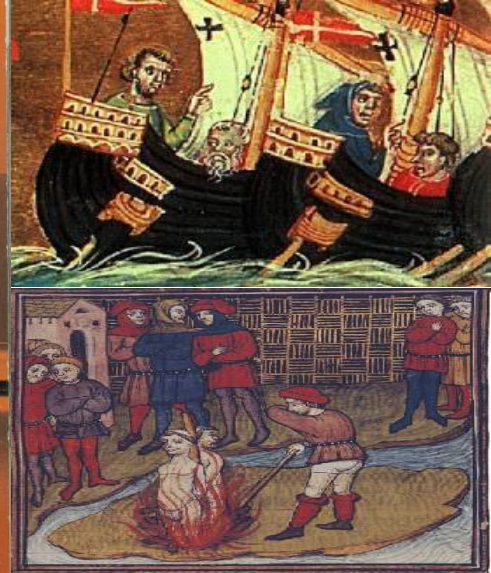

**At the dawn of modern life the Knights Templars inaugurated practical and culturally renewing initiatives in the fields of architecture, agriculture, banking, finance, medicine, and community life.** On Friday, 13<sup>th</sup> October 1307 Templar initiatives were impeded by a jealous king, who later condemned leading knights to burn at the stake.
